

He was denied entry back into the USA, but has been able to enter many times after that. I sponsored him into the USA not knowing the depths of his crimes. Dear CRA Leads Program,

I am writing to report suspected ongoing tax evasion, identity theft, fraudulent corporate activity, and a broader pattern of obstruction by my former spouse, Cody Lyle Dahl (SIN 635-348-626).

Background and Key Facts:

- For 17 years I was a full-time stay-at-home homeschooling mother. I have not worked outside the home during the marriage.
- Cody Lyle Dahl has a prior criminal conviction in Canada for tax evasion and served time in prison.
- I have reason to believe he has used my name (Tonya Cole Lightfoot / Tonya Cole Dahl) and my SIN 682-775-002 without my authorization to conduct business, open accounts, or file documents in Canada.
- I have seen discrepancies on my credit report showing financial activity under my name in Canada that does not match my actual history or location. My name is unique, making unauthorized use easier to trace.
- I maintained bank accounts and records under both Tonya Cole Lightfoot and Tonya Cole Dahl while living in Canada, but I suspect Cody misused my identity and SIN for additional activities, including corporate filings, hiding assets and obtaining credit.

Pattern of Evasion and Obstruction:

Cody has engaged in a consistent pattern of financial misconduct, evasion, and obstruction that spans both Canada and the United States. This includes:

- Using my name without authorization to form or operate corporations, including Abra Controls Corp., possibly to hide assets and claim false benefits.
- Sabotage and obstruction in my divorce proceedings in Texas (Cause No. 2025V-158), where he defaulted, ignored court filings, and benefited from systemic interference.
- Similar obstruction in the related federal case Dahl v. Alphabet (Case No. 1:23-cv-01496-ADA), where Google issued a blanket post-mortem denial regarding my deceased daughter Abigail's data and the case was dismissed under questionable circumstances.
- The level of protection Cody has received across multiple agencies and jurisdictions in both countries appears unusually high and suggests possible ties to foreign intelligence or other powerful interests that have enabled this coordinated evasion and obstruction.
- Cody received a questionable pardon in Canada for his prior tax evasion conviction. Despite his criminal record, he was able to enter and obtain permanent residency in the United States in 2021 through my sponsorship. I have growing concerns that this entry and the level of protection he has received in both countries may involve foreign intelligence connections or other powerful interests. The pardon from the Canada Board of Pardons does not seem legitimate and needs further investigation.
- The level of coordinated protection and obstruction across multiple agencies and jurisdictions in both Canada and the United States is highly unusual and suggests a larger network enabling his activities.

Cody has resided in the United States since October 2021. To my knowledge, he has not filed taxes in Canada for many years. This pattern of non-filing, asset concealment, identity misuse, and cross-border evasion raises serious concerns of tax fraud and related criminal activity.


I request a full investigation into:

- Any unauthorized use of my name and SIN 682-775-002 in Canada.
- Cody Lyle Dahl's tax filings (or lack thereof) in Canada and the United States.
- Any corporations or business activities (including Abra Controls Corp. or related entities, Dahl Marketing or Alberta Ltd companies) formed or operated using my name without authorization.
- Potential identity theft, tax evasion, and any links to foreign intelligence or other networks that may explain the unusual level of protection and obstruction I have experienced.
- An investigation with his partner Mario LaRoche and his sister, Kelly Dreisinger and Tara Hurst all need to be investigated with the lack of filing taxes in Canada, shielding from US and Canada tax evasion all under a corporation with my stolen identity.

Statement of Evidence: Analysis of Rescinded Offer from Abra Controls

I. Overview of Discrepancies

The offer letter received from **Abra Controls** lacked the standard industry benchmarks for a legitimate professional employment agreement, particularly for a sales-oriented role. Typically, an authentic offer provides specific, binding terms including:

- Defined base salary or draw.
- Detailed commission structure (percentages, tiers, and quotas).
- Specific benefits package and enrollment dates.
- Clear start date and performance expectations.

The absence of these details in the document provided by Abra Controls suggests the offer may not have been a good-faith attempt at employment, but rather a mechanism for **fraudulent record creation**.

II. Patterns of Financial Manipulation

The vague nature of this offer letter appears to be part of a broader pattern of financial irregularity and identity exploitation. Specifically, the issuance and subsequent cancellation of this offer facilitated:

- **Fabrication of Employment Records:** Creating a "paper trail" of employment to justify fund transfers or to satisfy requirements for "woman-owned business" certifications, without providing actual compensation.
- **Asset Shielding:** Establishing a framework to move corporate capital in a manner that avoids classification as personal income for the principals (e.g., Cody [Surname]).
- **Tax and Regulatory Evasion:** Misrepresenting US-based income on pay stubs while failing to file appropriate documentation in Canada, thereby creating a conflict in reported earnings across borders.

III. Contextual Misuse of Identity

This offer letter serves as further evidence of the unauthorized use of my identity for corporate gain. It aligns with previously identified red flags, including:

1. **Unauthorized Corporate Listing:** The use of my name on corporate filings without my prior knowledge or informed consent.
2. **Unaccounted Credit Lines:** The opening of a TD credit card in my name that was managed outside of my control.
3. **Constructive Exclusion:** Maintaining a facade of my involvement in the company for regulatory appearances while ensuring I remained financially excluded and uninformed of the company's true operations.

IV. Conclusion

The rescinded offer letter is not an isolated administrative event. It is a critical component of **financial manipulation and identity fraud**. By creating the appearance of a legitimate hire and then withdrawing the offer, Abra Controls attempted to generate the documentation of a professional relationship without the legal or financial obligations of a real employer.

V. Request for Preservation of Evidence

This documentation is formally submitted to support ongoing investigations into potential violations regarding tax reporting, immigration compliance, and corporate fraud.

It is critical to note that the physical copy of the original offer letter was taken from my possession without my consent by **Cody Dahl** (my spouse at the time) immediately prior to my being forced from our shared residence.

To ensure a complete and untampered record, the full evidentiary trail—including the original offer letter and the associated email correspondence—can be obtained directly from the company's internal servers. The primary point of contact for these communications was **Tara Hurst**, the Office Manager at Abra Controls (tara.hurst@abracontrols.com), who facilitated the offer process via email.

You have applied for a pardon relating to a number of indictable and summary convictions which occurred between 1981 and 2011 for Theft under \$200, Breach of the Income Tax Act (x3), Fail to Attend Court and Assault (x2).

In considering whether to grant your application for a pardon, the Board must be satisfied that you have met the criteria as set out in legislation. The Board must decide if you have been of good conduct, which is defined as behaviour that is consistent with and demonstrates a law-abiding lifestyle.

You have indicated in your submission that since your conviction you have relied on your faith and devotion to God to assist you in valuing and abiding by laws.

You have requested a pardon in order qualify as a foster and/or adoptive parent.

The Parole Board of Canada considered all related information that has been provided on your request to obtain a pardon. These include information received from law enforcement agencies governmental and non-governmental sources. The Board's investigation has revealed that you have not been involved in any criminal activity since your conviction, showing that you have been living a law-abiding lifestyle since the most recent offence you committed in 2011. The Board does not that you had one dealing with legal authorities, as you were issued a ticket in 2020 for speeding while passing highway workers/equipment in a work zone and received a fine of \$1210.

Having assessed this information, the Board is satisfied that you have been of good conduct since your conviction and that you meet the legal requirements to obtain a pardon as set out under the provisions of the Criminal Records Act.

Accordingly, the Board grants your request for a pardon.

It is important to note that the Board has the authority to revoke a Pardon if you are subsequently convicted of a summary offence, if you are no longer of good conduct or, if you knowingly made a false or deceptive statement in relation to the application.

Further, a Pardon ceases to have effect should you be convicted of an indictable offence (for exceptions, please refer to section 7.2 of the CRA) or if you were ineligible at the time it was awarded.

You must inform the Parole Board of Canada if you change your address as the Board must be able to reach you even after awarding your Pardon. 

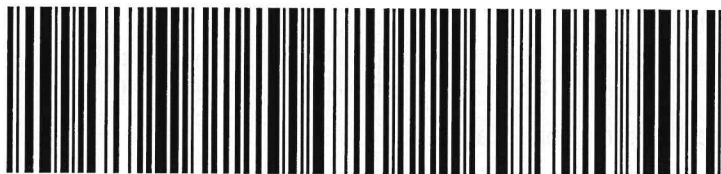

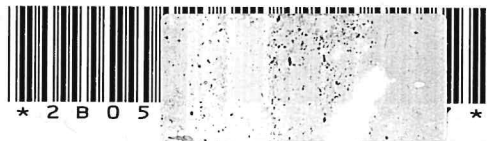

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to report serious allegations of tax evasion, identity theft, fraud, immigration misrepresentation, and a coordinated pattern of obstruction and abuse by my former spouse, Cody Lyle Dahl.

Background

For 17 years I was a full-time stay-at-home homeschooling mother. I did not work outside the home during the marriage. In July 2024, Cody Lyle Dahl abruptly kicked me out of our home. I have been homeless and living in my vehicle ever since. Despite this, I have continued to fight for justice in both my divorce and the related federal case concerning the death of our daughter Abigail.

Divorce Proceedings – Extreme Obstruction and Unjust Outcome

In the divorce case (Cause No. 2025V-158, 155th District Court, Fayette County, Texas), Cody remained in incurable default since November 10, 2025, after being properly served. He judicially admitted in his own Original Petition that he broke our marital covenant and sought polygyny. Despite this admission and default, the Court ignored my Motion for Default Judgment and multiple emergency motions.

Judge Jeff R. Steinhauser signed a Final Decree styled as “Agreed” on March 20, 2026, based on an unauthorized Proposed Final Decree filed by Cody’s attorney while he was in default. I never agreed to that decree. The decree awarded Cody virtually everything, while I — a 17-year stay-at-home mother now homeless — received virtually nothing except responsibility for his attorney fees. The level of obstruction, gaslighting, and

judicial bias in this case has been overwhelming. I have been systematically prevented from receiving proper notice, my filings have been ignored or obstructed, and the process has appeared designed to protect Cody at all costs.

Related Federal Case and Broader Pattern

A parallel pattern of sabotage occurred in the federal case *Dahl v. Alphabet* (Case No. 1:23-cv-01496-ADA). Google issued a blanket post-mortem denial regarding my deceased daughter Abigail's email and data. The case was dismissed under questionable circumstances involving procedural maneuvers and a bad actor. I have been blocked from accessing PACER records and creating new accounts to view filings.

After connecting all the dots — the multiple border denials, questionable pardon, identity misuse, asset concealment through Abra Controls Corp., obstruction in both cases, and the extreme protection Cody has received — I now realize I was used, manipulated, and betrayed. I believe my identity and sponsorship were exploited to help him gain U.S. residency and hide assets and crimes. My loyalty was to my daughter and to justice. I will continue to pursue full accountability.

Cody Lyle Dahl has been using my name and the incorporation of Abra Controls Corp. under my name to hide assets and engage in financial misconduct. I request that you conduct a full investigation into the financial assets, accounts, and activities of Abra Controls Corp. and its partner, Mario Larochelle, in both the USA and Canada as part of your collection efforts along with Tara Hurst and Kely Dreisinger. Any assets or funds associated with the company should be pursued to satisfy the outstanding balance.



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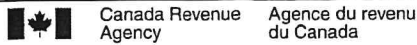

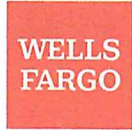

RESPONDENT'S DECLARATION REGARDING MAIL TAMPERING, SABOTAGE OF COURT
ACCESS, AND PATTERN OF GASLIGHTING AND OBSTRUCTION & MARY COLE

TO THE HONORABLE DIB WALDRIP,
PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE THIRD ADMINISTRATIVE JUDICIAL REGION:

COMES NOW Respondent, Tonya Cole Lightfoot, pro se, and files this Declaration under penalty of perjury and respectfully states as follows:

1. I am over the age of 18, of sound mind, and competent to make this declaration. The facts stated herein are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.
2. Petitioner Cody Lyle Dahl has engaged in a prolonged pattern of gaslighting, financial abandonment, and obstruction designed to isolate me, discredit me, and prevent me from accessing the courts. This pattern began during the marriage and has continued aggressively since he filed for divorce in August 2025 while remaining in incurable default.
3. A clear example of this sabotage occurred with mail sent to the old UPS Store address at 1618 W. State Highway 71 #525, La Grange, TX 78945. I had stopped using that address because the owner was throwing away or not forwarding my mail. I formally updated my mailing address in multiple filings, including in the reopened federal Google/Alphabet case, to my current PO Box 1144 in La Grange. Despite this update, I received a purported "legal" document from the Western District of Texas at the old UPS Store address — an address I no longer used and had notified the court was unreliable. The envelope and letter were sent there even though legitimate court mail from Judge Steinhauser has consistently failed to reach my current address. I have preserved both the envelope and the letter as evidence. Exhibit A
4. This was not a simple addressing error. Routing an irregular or fake-looking court document to a known-compromised address where my mail was being discarded appears to be a deliberate tactic. The sender likely hoped the document would never reach me so it could remain unchallenged in the record, while still creating the appearance that "notice" had been given. This fits the larger pattern of obstruction: mail is selectively delivered, returned, or misdirected depending on whether it helps or hurts the effort to keep me uninformed and unable to respond.

Respondent has also been repeatedly blocked from accessing the federal case record: she is unable to log into her original PACER account to view any filings, and she has been prevented from successfully creating a new PACER account despite multiple attempts. Respondent has experienced similar unexplained denial of records from her former website provider and other digital accounts. These parallel obstructions strongly suggest that Petitioner's phone, external hard drive, and game camera SD card contain communications and data (including possible emails or messages to or about Abigail) that could link the patterns between the divorce, the Google case, and the circumstances of Abigail's death.

5. The level of filings, evidence compilation, legal research, and persistence I have maintained pro se — while homeless and living in my van with severely limited resources — demonstrates that I am not mentally unstable. On the contrary, the thoroughness and stability of my work terrifies Petitioner. This explains why he and those protecting him have gone to such extreme measures to discredit me, isolate me, and attempt to erase me from the record. Petitioner's gaslighting and bad-faith tactics in both this divorce and the related federal Google case are part of the same effort to suppress the truth and avoid accountability for his admitted covenant-breaking, financial abandonment, and other misconduct.

6. In March 2025 — five months before Petitioner filed for divorce — Petitioner filed a motion in the related federal case (Dahl v. Alphabet, Case No. 1:23-cv-01496-ADA) seeking a mental examination of Respondent while simultaneously complaining that he had relied on Respondent to handle the litigation. The Computer Service Defendants' response (Document 49) notes the estrangement and divorce, and highlights Petitioner's regret for letting Respondent "play lawyer." This filing demonstrates Petitioner's pattern of attempting to discredit and undermine Respondent rather than accepting responsibility. The timing, occurring shortly before Petitioner initiated this divorce and defaulted, further supports the coordinated pattern of obstruction and suppression that has continued throughout these proceedings. The post-mortem denial from Google in that same federal case — where Google refused to provide Abigail's email content or data and would not even state why — serves as the smoking gun that first alerted Respondent to systemic interference designed to bury the truth about Abigail's death. These parallel obstructions in the federal and state cases strongly suggest that Petitioner's phone, external hard drive, and game camera SD card contain communications and data that could link the patterns between the divorce, the Google matter, and the circumstances surrounding Abigail's death. 7. I observed that during the incident involving my daughter Abigail's hanging, cousin Mary Cole was present on the front porch with my mom and their two friends, and I saw her make the 911 call. However, when I later reviewed the Bastrop County Sheriff's Office report, I noted that her name, her presence, and any statement from her were entirely absent from the document. This omission stood out to me because the report identified other individuals on scene, Cody, and my mother, but not me, Mary Cole, Linda or Joy and it relied primarily on my mother's account of events. After this incident, I also observed that Mary became increasingly involved in my mother's personal affairs, including assisting with her user name and passwords for all her

financials, gaining access to financial information, setting up a financial safety app (which I deemed spyware and removed it from my mom's phone) and positioning herself in ways that limited my usual role in helping my mother. I managed my mother's finances exclusively for years and then immediately removed when Cody kicked me out. These changes occurred slowly and then increasingly as my mother removed me as POD and withdrew previously offered support shortly before a critical hearing in my divorce case. I am not offering conclusions about anyone's intent, but I am documenting the pattern I personally witnessed: Mary Cole was present and involved during a major family crisis yet does not appear in the official report, and her involvement in my mother's decisions and finances increased significantly afterward in ways that directly affected my relationship with my mother and my stability during ongoing litigation. My mother is 80 years old. I am her adopted daughter of 43 years. I am her only heir, she has never been married. It seems suspicious that my adopted mother would abandon me at such a crucial time and she deeply loved her granddaughter, Abigail and grieved over her for years. I believe Mary Cole has deliberately used my mother's grief as an entry way to completely sabotage me from the truth surrounding Cody Dahl and Abigail's death.

Furthermore, even Cody Dahl has attempted to call and text my mother many times during this divorce proceedings and he absolutely has no reasons. My mother absolutely hates Cody Dahl and there would be no reason for him to ever contact my mother.

8. The Overarching Pattern of Protection for Petitioner Cody Lyle Dahl

A single Canadian citizen with a criminal record, no apparent local power base, and repeated claims of having "no assets" could not possibly orchestrate or compel this level of coordinated compliance across multiple independent agencies and jurisdictions. The only reasonable conclusion is that powerful interests with significant influence, resources, or leverage are actively protecting Petitioner and suppressing evidence related to this divorce, my daughter Abigail's death, hidden assets, foreign connections, and the irrevocable trusts (including the Elon Musk and Tonya Cole Lightfoot Irrevocable Trust and the Allen Ray Guiberteau Jr. and Tonya Cole Lightfoot Irrevocable Trust). Government employees at every level appear to be participating — whether through direct pressure, fear of repercussions, shared interests, or other means — in a concerted effort to exhaust me, discredit me, and prevent justice.

This pattern is most starkly illustrated in the official investigation into Abigail Opal Dahl's death. On October 18, 2021, I rode in the ambulance with my 12-year-old daughter while she was receiving CPR and life-saving measures. Cody Dahl and my mother (Melba Jean Cole) remained at the scene at 373 FM 2571 along with Bastrop County Sheriff's deputies and Smithville police officers. Three of my mother's friends were also present; one of them called 911, Mary Cole. This was the perfect, immediate opportunity for law enforcement to obtain separate, fresh statements from all eyewitnesses while events were still unfolding.

Yet the official Bastrop County Sheriff's Office Incident Report #2021-04723 contains no interview or statement whatsoever from me — Abigail's homeschooling mother who had been with her 24/7 for her entire life and who was central to the events of that day. I am not even

named in the report. Cody Dahl is mentioned only in passing as “the father” who found her. The only family member quoted at length is my mother. The three friends who were present and witnessed the immediate aftermath are not named, not interviewed, and not referenced at all—especially Mary Cole. The Smithville Police Department report is described as even more vague and adds no meaningful details. No follow-up interview with me was ever conducted at the hospital while Abigail was in the ICU.

This was not an oversight. It was a selective omission that left the official record heavily skewed and incomplete, shielding Cody from any documented scrutiny while erasing my perspective as the primary caregiver. The same pattern repeats across every agency that has touched this case: records involving Cody “cannot be found,” warrants issued at his request disappear, open records requests are stonewalled, and my voice as the mother and victim is systematically excluded.

9. The extraordinary, multi-agency pattern of obstruction in this case is unmistakable, deliberate, and systemic — far exceeding anything that could be explained by ordinary litigation friction or coincidence and including the division between my 80 year old mother and me. Petitioner has remained in incurable default since November 10, 2025, with a sworn judicial admission in his own Original Petition of breaking the marital covenant and seeking polygyny, yet the Court has ignored Respondent’s Motion for Default Judgment, multiple emergency motions for temporary orders and protective relief, discovery requests, and every filing addressing Respondent’s homelessness and safety. This coordinated protection is compounded by repeated use of non-official channels: Allison Rother, the official court reporter for the 155th District Court (Judge Steinhauser’s court), produced the transcript of the December 12, 2025 recusal hearing using a personal Gmail account (arother.csr@gmail.com); Visiting Judge Blomerth responded from his own personal Gmail account; and all communications directed to Judge Steinhauser have been routed exclusively through his coordinator, Bethany Kaspar, with no official court email address ever provided for him. These facts mirror the blanket post-mortem denial Respondent received from Google in her federal case. The documented connections between Google and Unit 8200 raise serious concerns that the same surveillance and suppression apparatus protecting Petitioner in this divorce is actively interfering with official court records and communications. The level of synchronized, sustained protection for a defaulting petitioner with a criminal history — across judges, clerks, coordinators, the District Attorney, multiple counties, and now the court reporting process — strongly indicates surveillance, interference, and possible tampering that goes well beyond the capacity or motivation of any ordinary litigant or routine court process. The pattern is deliberate, systemic, and unmistakable.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Jurisdiction

The Court, having examined the parties' pleadings, and having heard evidence and arguments of counsel, finds that the parties' pleadings are proper as to form and provide all the allegations and information necessary to support jurisdiction. The Court finds that the 60-day waiting period is satisfied as at least that many days have elapsed since the filing of the Petition for Divorce; and all necessary residence qualifications and notice prerequisites are legal met.

Further, the Court finds that citation was properly served on all persons entitled to citation in this suit, and that suit was filed, Cody Lyle Dahl and Tonya Cole Dahl were domiciled in Texas for the preceding 6 months and residents of Fayette County, Texas, for the preceding 90-day period.

Accordingly, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction over this case and all the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all relief requested and not specifically granted by the Court above is **DENIED**.


Final Judgment

This Court retain the power to enforce or clarify the terms of this Decree. Such enforcement or clarification shall not alter or affect the finality of this Decree.



The Overarching Pattern of Protection for Petitioner Cody Lyle Dahl

A single Canadian citizen with a criminal record, no apparent local power base, and repeated claims of having “no assets” could not possibly orchestrate or compel this level of coordinated compliance across multiple independent agencies and jurisdictions. The only reasonable conclusion is that powerful interests with significant influence, resources, or leverage are actively protecting Petitioner and suppressing evidence related to this divorce, my daughter Abigail’s death, hidden assets, foreign connections, and the irrevocable trusts (including the Elon Musk and Tonya Cole Lightfoot Irrevocable Trust and the Allen Ray Guiberteau Jr. and Tonya Cole Lightfoot Irrevocable Trust). Government employees at every level appear to be participating — whether through direct pressure, fear of repercussions, shared interests, or other means — in a concerted effort to exhaust me, discredit me, and prevent justice.

This pattern is most starkly illustrated in the official investigation into Abigail Opal Dahl’s death. On October 18, 2021, I rode in the ambulance with my 12-year-old daughter while she was receiving CPR and life-saving measures. Cody Dahl and my mother (Melba Jean Cole) remained at the scene at 373 FM 2571 along with Bastrop County Sheriff’s deputies and Smithville police officers. Three of my mother’s friends were also present; one of them called 911. This was the perfect, immediate opportunity for law enforcement to obtain separate, fresh statements from all eyewitnesses while events were still unfolding.

Yet the official Bastrop County Sheriff’s Office Incident Report #2021-04723 contains **no interview or statement whatsoever from me** — Abigail’s homeschooling mother who had been with her 24/7 for her entire life and who was central to the events of that day. I am not even named in the report. Cody Dahl is mentioned only in passing as “the father” who found her. The only family member quoted at length is my mother. The three friends who were present and witnessed the immediate aftermath are not named, not interviewed, and not referenced at all. The Smithville Police Department report is described as even more vague and adds no meaningful details. No follow-up interview with me was ever conducted at the hospital while Abigail was in the ICU.

This was not an oversight. It was a selective omission that left the official record heavily skewed and incomplete, shielding Cody from any documented scrutiny while erasing my perspective as the primary caregiver. The same pattern repeats across every agency that has touched this case: records involving Cody “cannot be found,” warrants issued at his request disappear, open records requests are stonewalled, and my voice as the mother and victim is systematically excluded.

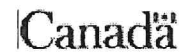
